Boaterz n Bikerz of America Roll into New England This Week

On Saturday, July 15, the 2017 Boaterz n Bikerz of America HULL OF A TOUR officially kicks off in Naples, ME at Moose Landing Marina. This touring group of boating industry folk who are passionate motorcyclists is launching its fourth annual trek, this year cruising throughout New England.

Organized by Wanda Kenton Smith of Freedom Boat Club and Jim Krueger of Regal Boats, the adventure is unique in that it mixes both boating and motorcycling activities in an escorted tour format. This year, riders will experience spectacular mountain and coastal riding through Maine, New Hampshire, Massachusetts and Rhode Island.

Boat stops include an opening breakfast cruise hosted by Moose Landing Marina aboard Regal sportboats, the official boat sponsor of the tour. The group will also enjoy a whale watching trip in Lubec, ME take a duck tour in Cape Cod hosted by the Massachusetts Marine Trade Association, and take a lazy tube float down the Penobscot River, sponsored by BRP/Evinrude.

Two Freedom Boat Club events are co-hosted by the franchisor who serves as the tour's presenting sponsor, and two New England franchises. Riders will take an afternoon spin aboard fleet boats in Portsmouth, New Hampshire, and then toast success at the grand finale, a sunset dinner cruise splashdown in Newport aboard a double-decker private party charter, Amazing Grace.

In addition to the special events, Sea Tow is aboard this year as the official Chase Vehicle sponsor, which will be driven by Boating contributor former Yachting Editor John Wooldridge.

"We're ready to rock and roll," said Kenton Smith. "This event celebrates boating, motorcycling and the great outdoors ... what could be more fun!"
